

## **Residential 4-Hour Authorized Person**

### **Who is this class for?**

This “user training” class is for anyone who works at heights on a residential site and has to use Fall Protection.

### **What does the class entail?**

At the beginning of the class, we will provide you with a manual. We will present a PowerPoint presentation with hands on exercise. We will cover the following:

- We discuss all parts of the Fall Protection Hierarchy
- We spend a great deal of time covering the four parts of the Fall Arrest System inspection of the system
- The proper donning of the harness, proper usage of the equipment, how to maintain the equipment, when and where the equipment is needed.

We also have hands-on exercises throughout the class, along with a Fall Protection demonstration to show how the amount of arresting force is generated, utilizing various types of lanyards. At the end of the class, we will issue a test to make sure the information is retained. Shortly after the conclusion of the class, we will issue cards of completion for those students who passed the test.

### **What happens if a person is using Fall Protection equipment outside of its limitations?**

It will not work properly! The myth is, "If I am wearing the gear, I must be protected." Not true. You must wear the gear, and it must be hooked to an anchor; not hooked to just anything you can find or which way you want, but to a suitable anchor with the system tied off within the limitations of the equipment. Also, the equipment must be inspected prior to use to ensure the integrity of all components. Each employee is responsible for inspecting his or her equipment before using it.

### **Where can Safety Connection, Inc. perform the class?**
